



UWP Primary Uniform Expectations

Uniforms are REQUIRED Monday through Friday, NO EXCEPTIONS

MONDAY - FRIDAY BOTTOMS

MON.

- Short or Long Sleeve White oxford shirt with crest and tie.
- Black, Gray, or Navy-Blue Bottoms for Boys Girls may wear the plaid skirts as well
- Long sleeves must be buttoned
- Shirts must be always tucked in
- Only Solid White undershirts allowed

No colored or logo shirts allowed underneath uniform shirt

TUE. To THUR.

- Short or Long Sleeve Navy Blue Collared shirt
- Black, Gray, or Navy-Blue Bottoms for Boys
 - Girls may wear the plaid skirts as well
- Long sleeves must be buttoned
- Shirts must be always tucked in
- Only Solid White undershirts allowed

No colored or logo shirts allowed underneath uniform shirt

FRIDAY

• On Fridays and **Friday's Only** scholars may wear jeans with a university or school uniform shirt including Williams spirit shirts.

- Navy Blue, Gray and Black Uniform **Pants**
- Pants/Shorts should be worn appropriately and modestly
- Kindergarten and 1st Grade only- may wear elastic waist Pants/Shorts
- Plaid Mills Uniform Jumper

- o Must be worn with Mills Solid Navy Blue modesty shorts underneath
- O No long pants under allowed underneath

Plaid Mills Skort

- Jumper/Skort may not be shorter than width of credit card measured at the back of the knee
- Jumper/Skort's waistband must be at the waist

OUTERWEAR / BACKPACKS / UMBRELLAS / RAINCOATS / PONCHOS Navy Blue Mills Sweater, Cardigan, or Vests may be worn in the classroom

- Navy Blue Mills Sweatshirt or

Fleece may be worn in the classroom

- Backpacks must be Clear and should be an appropriate size for your scholar
 - Rolling backpacks are not allowed
 - Items such as key chains that dangle are not allowed
 - Scholars are encouraged to limit the weight in their backpack
- **Raincoats** or **Ponchos** are allowed Scholars are encouraged to keep a poncho in their backpack at all times

BELTS / SOCKS/ SHOES / TIGHTS

- Black Belt woven or flat with a small buckle
 - Required for 1st 5th grade
 - No design or logo buckles/belts allowed
- Socks must be solid navy blue, white or black
 - No socks with designs or logos allowed
 - Knee length socks preferred with Jumper/Skorts
 - Socks must cover the ankle bone
 - No-show socks are not allowed
- **Shoes** must be all white athletic tennis shoes (with white laces) or must be all black athletic tennis shoes (with black laces)
 - Pre-K and Kindergarten may wear shoes above with Velcro
 - Shoe accessories are not allowed 0
 - Shoes and laces must be kept in good 0
 - condition

Dress shoes are not allowed

Scholars must wear closed toe shoes

that

- they can run around and remain safe,
- preferably athletic shoes.
- Heelys are not allowed
- Tights (waist to toe) can be worn in solid navy blue, opaque white or black
 - Socks may not be worn over tights
 - Leggings are not permitted
