ABOUT OUR NETWORK


Uplift's mission is to create and sustain public schools of excellence that empower scholars to reach their highest potential in college and the global marketplace. We strive to inspire a life-long love of learning, achievement, and service to positively change our world.

Established in 1996, we are the largest public charter school network in North Texas. Our campuses are open-enrollment, and we provide a free, college-preparatory education to every scholar we serve.

Our goal is for 70% of our graduates to earn a college degree within six years of high school graduation. We aggressively pursue this goal by working to close the opportunity gap for our scholars, regardless of their ethnic or socioeconomic background, ensuring that 100% of our scholars graduate and have the opportunity to pursue their best-fit post-secondary pathway.

The Road to College and Career (RTCC) program at Uplift Education supports scholars and families as they prepare to reach their full potential in the global marketplace. The RTCC program has two primary goals: 1) 70% of Uplift graduates will earn a college degree within six years of graduation. 2) 90% of Uplift graduates will earn an economically viable post-secondary credential and career pathway. The RTCC team accomplishes these goals in six key ways: 1) RTCC Campus Offices, 2) Career Exploration & Experiences, 3) Family Involvement, 4) Stop-Out Support, 5) Alumni Career Office, 6) Persistence Support.

Currently, 73% of Uplift graduates are enrolled in college or have already earned a bachelor's degree. Additionally, 90% of alumni who used Uplift Career Services reported that the support they received helped them secure a job or internship.

Currently, 100% of our eligible primary, middle and high schools are authorized to offer the International Baccalaureate[®] program, making us one of the top five IB districts in the nation.


As IB continuum schools, our high schools are authorized to offer both the Middle Years Programme (MYP) for grades 6-10 and the Diploma Programme (DP) for grades 11-12. Uplift is a DP For ALL network and is committed to making sure that all scholars, regardless of their background or educational need, have access to participate in the Diploma Programme.

Beginning with the Class of 2020, all scholars have had the opportunity to pursue the full Diploma Programme. Our scholars are also required to participate in the DP Core by taking a Theory of Knowledge course, completing a Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS) project, and writing the Extended Essay.

FAMILY ENGAGEMENT:

The Road to College and Career team is committed to deepening our relationships with families and provide the information and tools needed to support their high school education and college and career choices. We do this by partnering with families to navigate various elements on the Road to College and Career, such as an IB education, connecting college to career and how a college education provides social and economic mobility.




